About the University

On 23rd August, 1958, Pandit Jawaharlal Nehru, the then Prime Minister of India, inaugurated the Marathwada University. On 14th January 1994, the University was renamed 'Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University' to pay homage to the work done by Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar for the educational development of Marathwada region. This University has been the premier educational institution catering to the needs of the Marathwada region. The objectives of the University are to create, preserve and disseminate knowledge through teaching, research and extension activities. Situated on about 700 acres of land, the University is adorned with scenic beauty and magnificent historicity.

At present Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University has 42 Departments and more than 400 affiliate colleges catering to the needs of 1.45 lakh students. This University is educating the rural youth coming from socially and economically backward communities struggling for their career. It reflects the social commitment of our University. Equipped with highly sophisticated infrastructure and strong commitment to the promotion of excellence in higher education, the university is focusing on starting new professional courses to provide trained and skilled manpower to industry.

Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University has received national recognition. In survey of India Today on 5th August, 2015 University secured 18th rank among 800 universities in India and 3rd rank in western India. In the 2021 National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF) survey by the ministry of human resource development (MHRD), New Delhi, our university ranked 26th in the country. In 'The Week-Hansa' research survey of best Universities in India in 2016, our University obtained 55th rank in India and 11th rank among top 20 universities in west Zone in India. The electronic copy should be emailed to: cpepa2017@gmail.com and the authors of the selected papers/ articles shall be intimated in due course by mail only. The acceptance of the manuscript implies that at least one of the authors will attend the conference and make presentation. Participation/ presentation certificate shall not be given for participation in absentia. Papers must include a clear indication of the purpose of research, methodology, major results, and implications and key references. The author(s) should

clearly mention their affiliation as to which institution he/she belongs along with designation. Research papers/case studies /posters may be submitted in English/Marathi.

Poster Presentation

It should represent findings from a current working paper related to theme of the conference. Authors are required to display readable posters of their research, distribute their papers and be available to discuss and answer questions during the assigned poster session. Submission of an electronic copy of the Poster in PDF format is must before the deadline (30th November, 2021). The poster should be in portrait layout only (not landscape layout) in A4 size.
