

#### PROGRAM OUTCOMES (POs)

LL.M Post- graduates will be able to:

- 1. **Domain Knowledge:** Apply the knowledge of fundamental Principles of Law in the area of Constitution, Criminal and Business Law for the solution of complex legal issues affecting the Society.
- 2. **Problem Analysis:** Identify, formulate, research literature and analyze complex legal issues/ problems reaching substantiated conclusions using provisions statutory of statutes, rules, regulations and principles of International legal instruments as well as judicial decisions.
- 3. Conduct investigations of Complex Problems: Use research-based knowledge and research methods including design of experiments, analysis and interpretation of data, and synthesis of the information to provide valid conclusions, to the legal problems.
- 4. Modern Tool Usage: Select and apply appropriate techniques using IT tools to access resources and legal databases providing Case Laws, Statutes, E-books and Journals.
- 5. Societal Responsibility: Apply reasoning informed by the contextual knowledge to assess legal issues affecting society and the consequent responsibilities relevant to the professional legal practice.
