3.2 Training:

1. Three Days Value Added Barkley's Life Skill Training Program

Training and Placement Cell and Internal Quality Assurance Cell of Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University in association with Tarabai Shinde Women's Studies Centre organized a three-day Value Added Course called "Barkley's Life-Skills Training Program" in Fatima Sheikh Auditorium of Tarabai Shinde Women's Studies Centre for the students of Tarabai Shinde Women's Studie Centre & library and information science department. It was held from 11 to 13 January 2023. The program was inaugurated on On January 11, the president of this program and the director of Tarabai Shinde Women's Studies Centre Dr.Mehrunnisa Pathan. 





2. An Awareness Workshop on W20: G20 Women Led Development

In 1999, the United Nations adopted the Optional Protocol to the Convention on the Elimination of allforms of discrimination against Women and designated 25th November as the International Day for the Elimination of Violence against Women. The purpose of the day is to raise awareness around the world that women are subjected to rape, domestic violence and other forms of violence furthermore, one of the aims of the day is to highlight that the scale and true nature of the issue is often hidden.

This session was chaired by Dr.MehrunnisaPathan, I/c.Director, Tarabai Shinde Women's Studies Centre, who introduced about various waves of Feminism. She discussed especially about the fourth wave of digital feminism. Digital feminism is the contemporary wave of feminism. The digital revolution has paved the way for a new iteration of feminism. The digital space can bolster feminist activist movements by encouraging inclusion and improving accessibility in organising collective action. It also helps weave local stories with global narratives to highlight common structural inequalities. At the same time, however, the digital space can also become a breeding ground for sexism and misogyny.

Besides this the centre has organized Gender Orientations workshops in various colleges affiliated to the university. It's a matter of great satisfaction and pride that a huge number of students participated in these workshops and the centre could dialogue with these future citizens of India on their questions and queries on gender issues. The centre has also asked the university to introduce an optional certificate course in women's studies at undergraduate; the centre has designed syllabus and whole structure of the course. The centre has also offered to train the aspiring faculties interested in coordinating and running the course. The centre has jointly organized various programmes with other university departments and other social organizations and movements to outreach in the society.

3.7 Success Stories

- Recognition of the centre as a Research Centre for the Women Studies. Thirteen students doing Ph.D research in the field of Women's Studies.
- Tarabai Shinde Women's Studies centre has tried to translate and produce reading material especially in the regional language Marathi. It has been a very successful act because the students and researchers who are not well verse in English language finding it very useful and significant. Thus just not only the students from the women's studies centre but also the researchers from the affiliated colleges do visit the library at the centre and refer this literature. The centre is continuously engaged in producing maximum reading literature in regional language Marathi thus could expand the discourse of women's studies to a wider range of students and researchers.

Milun saryajani has been a pioneering mouthpiece Marathi journal of women's movement in Maharashtra. It's a significant historic document of various issues raised by the women's movement and the transitions that came in women's movement. The issues of the journal are immensely helpful to study the women's movement not just in Maharashtras but all over India. In the year of 2015-16 Tarabai Shinde Women's Studies centre has collected all the issue of the Journal Milun Saryajani and now the centre has 199 months issues of Milun Saryajani and it's a significant resource that has been made available by the centre for the researchers doing research in the respected areas.

Speaking on the occasion, Dr. Bagade explained that women's liberation movement, untouchables' movement, workers' movement, farmers' movement, non-Brahmin movement in India all seem to have originated from truth-seeking ideology. The thread of all these seems to be the truth seeker's motivation and the center of thought.

At the same time, he explained that Mahatma Phule accepted both Karta Karma Sambandha and Conjecture Logic, but Mahatma Phule clearly rejected logic formed in the form of waves of imagination. Because in such an idea, logic is not visible but works to maintain social conventions, regressive stereotypes as well. He also explained that the creator created only one creation. But this creation works according to its own laws.

There is no intervention of God or intervention of Nirmika. All these things happen according to the laws of nature according to materialistic view. In the social system of that time, when the trend was that women should be taught how to manage the house, Mahatma Phule explained that women should be given knowledge of human values and experienced

knowledge should be given. Mahatma Phule opposed religious exploitation and explained that unequal power relations are the basic basis of exploitation.


Club. In the screening of a movie/ documentary/play is followed by energetic discussion, questions and answers.






10. Interaction Session with Dr. Ayesha Khan, Political Advisor, U.S. Consulate General, Mumbai.

She wanted to visit personally and gather the information especially of Aurangabad city in particular and Marathwada region in general.

She mentioned in her brief interaction that women of cosmopolitan cities are more open and at least they have some exposure in the main stream and they are also moving forward. - Women's issues and domestic violence
- Sex workers and their increasing numbers.

- Immediate government policies as remedy to these issues and problems women.

Prof. Prashant Amrutkar Sir, Dean, Faculty of Humanities, Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University, Aurangabad was present as chief guest of the function. He explained the power relationship in Indian families and also mentioned that the development of any nation solely depends on the status of women in the society. He asserted that fifty percent of world's population comprises of women. In this male dominated society, women have always suffered. Dean sir said that we need to make the women of our country socially, politically, financially, morally, culturally strong & need to correct men on their wrong actions. The position of women will change. In a country like India as mentioned in the United nations report that women constitutes half of the world's population, performs two third of the work, receives one tenth of the world's income and own less that one hundredth percent of the worlds property. One of the major problems with the women is their political representation and also participation. Not all women enjoy freedom and equal rights as men in the society. Even to elect a political leader or to cast vote is not in their hands they are not allowed to participate in elections. Still these are stigma or stereotypes that are associated with it.

The chair person Dr. Mehrunnisa Pathan, Inch. Director introduced the Resource person and also the chief guest. She also mentioned the Work, Structure, Growth and Courses that are taught at Tarabai Shinde Women's Studies Centre,

Bint-e-hawa group member Firdous Ramzani, Dr. Nirmala Jadhav, Mrs. Ashwini More, Dr. Savita Bahirat expressed their opinion on various issues such as women's subordination, Hijab issue, sex workers, Rape victims, NGO and socioeconomic report.

The researcher and scholars at Tarabai Shinde Women's Studies Centre, Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University, Aurangabad put forward their opinion about political condition of women, participation in electoral process, equality and freedom of women. Despite various provisions in the constitution, women in the Indian Sub constitution, women in the Indian subcontinent continue to be under represented in the legislature both of the state and national level. The number of female representatives in legislative bodies in the center and in most of the states of India are below 20% reflecting a pan Indian gender exclusion from electoral participation and equal representation. The Indian female participation in the electoral politics is very low due to the political party competitions at state level and national level. They discriminate in terms of seat allotments, the party rank and chain and command.

This is the major hindrance, the Indian politics ruled by inherent male dominance and patriarchal mindset that excludes women from the electrol process.

The audience also posed questions to Dr. Parvez Aslam regarding the women's political participation in municipal corporation election in Aurangabad and he tried to answer satisfactorily. It was also mentioned about child trafficking due to which the parents are reluctant to send their children to the schools. Though no case is registered about child trafficking in Aurangabad. Few activities are conducted but again they highlight cultural importance of women. It is only to promote cultural activities.

Before the Interaction Session Book Release program was organized. The Books the journal excel with impact factor more that 5. Agreed to publish the articles received for national seminar on Emancipation of Women: Issues and Challenges. The special issue of this journal has been dedicated to the publication of articles collected and received for seminar presentation. The articles written in Urdu, English, Hindi and Marathi are published separately. In all four volumes of the Excel Journal is dedicated to the seminar publications.
