Completed an inter-disciplinary research project titled 'Socio-scientific approach to conservation of Bidri Art with special reference to Soil Analysis' funded by the Department of Science and Technology (DST), Ministry of Science and Technology, Government of India; under the Science and Heritage Research Initiative (SHRI) initiative. The project aimed at deciphering the composition of clay, an operational requisite of Bidri handicraft. We strived to create a synthesis, that could make the handicraft economically viable for craftsmen; thereby mitigating artisan exodus and art-extinction.

We could accomplish the formulation; two of which were filed with the Indian Patents Office. One of them have been granted and the other is published. This project could also accomplish some of the coveted journal publications, which could act as a reference for future researchers in this understudied handicraft of *Bidri*.
