#### 3. <u>DETAILS</u>

#### 3.1 **Teaching**

The Interdisciplinary Ph.D, Masters degree & Post Graduate Certificate Course in Women's Studies are conducted at the Centre. Innovative teaching practices like discussion sessions, films screening, presentations, regular guest lectures and assignment based on field research, bilingual teaching method etc. are used. The students from almost all the disciplines like Arts, Science, Social Sciences, Law management, journalism, engineering, medical, and even foreign students do take admissions to the women's studies courses at the centre. Various NGO personnel working on women's issues even Nurses, social activists, and Human Rights activists enroll for the courses in women's studies. There have always been a significant number of housewives admitting for our courses. Thus we feel it's a recognition of the significance of these courses that people from almost all fields of life wants to do the courses and wants to get gender oriented through these courses.

#### 1. PhD in Womem's Studies –

Tarabai Shinde Women's Studies Centre was established in 2005 through university fund. In 2006 Centre started PG level part time Certificate Course in Women's Studies. In 2011-12, the centre started Master of Arts (M.A. Course in Women's Studies), and we are very proud that, in 2022, Centre is recognized by the University as a Research Centre. Presently 14 students are persuing their PhD research work in Women's Studies at Tarabai Shinde Women's Studies Centre.

The workshop was organized in five sessions. First- Inaugural session, Second-Technical Session: I , Third- Interactive Sessions with Grassroot Women Activists, Fourth-Technical Session: II and Fifth- Valedictory Session.

On this occasion Prof. Manimekalai, Director, Centre for Women and Development Studies, New Delhi; Prof. Chaya Datar, Ex, Director, Advanced Centre for Women's Studies, Tata Institute of Social Sciences, Mumbai; Prof. John Chelladurai, Dean, Faculty of Interdisciplinary Studies, MGM University, Chhatrapati Sambhajinagar; Prof. Wandana Sonalkar, Ex. Director, Advance centre for Women's Studies, Tata Institute of Social Science and Dr. Nirmla Jadhav, Director, Tarabai Shinde Women's Studies Centre were present.

The workshop started floral tribute to Krantiyoti Savitribai Phule and Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar. At the beginning welcome address was given by Dr. Nirmla Jadhav. She explained that we are now in the 21<sup>st</sup> century, but there are still serious issues regarding child marriage, higher education, employment, wage disparity, and workplace environment. Against this backdrop, it is important for students to reflect on the critical aspects of this report towards equality.

Prof. N. Manimekalai expressed her views on the Towards Equality Report and the work. In the inaugural session, Prof. Manimekalai explained that even after 50 years of Towards Equality Report, some structural differences in the case of women are still visible in the society. Like their active participation in local politics, employment issues, wage differentials, changing brutal forms of violence, ignorance about the digital economy, Economic participation, domestic violence still happening in the home, violence in the workplace are still issues we see today and it is important to recall this report and think again towards equality in this background.

Prof. Chhaya Datar drew attention to various social issues by taking their historical review in her inagural. Mathura rape case, Bhawari Devi case and now Nirbhaya case are all forms of inhumane violence against women. She explained that education with equality among men and women is very important. Prof. Chhaya Datar also expressed concern about the alarming statistics regarding the sex ratio that we are still struggling with and the ratio of girls in higher education, as well as the ratio in employment. She also mentioned that the proportion of girls should be increased in higher education and their proportion also needs to be increased in employment.

Prof. John Challadurai said that we always express the need to improve the society but how are we doing in our home? How are we behaving with our colleagues?, we should think about these things first. Because society is made up of all individuals. First we ourselves must accept the principle of equality. Prof. John Chelladurai while speaking on this occasion explained that we should respect the fundamental rights of everyone.

Dr. Vandana Sonalkar explained that we have theoretical thought based legacy and work of Mahatma Phule, Chhatrapati Shahu Maharaj, and Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar. Are we following this thought and action?, this is the biggest question today. Institutional levels in society are complementary to discrimination. We are lagging behind on many issues like health, culture, wage differentials, school dropout rates, higher education rates of women. As new research methods are emerging, it is necessary to study humanities before qualitative and quantitative aspects. Women's labor is still invisible in national production. We are witnessing conflicts in terms of caste, class and gender. Can women, whether women who work at home or women who work outside, enjoy the holiday in peace? This is an important question even today. And so it is important to study the report Towards Equality.

Dr. Gole explained that the methodology of knowledge creation is still developing from a patriarchal point of view. In which it is very necessary to be treated from a feminist point of view.



#### Grassroot Testimony: Sushila Morale, Beed

Sushila Morale while guiding the session explained that in 1975 the United Nations took up various programmes for women's upliftment. Above all, the challenge before us at that time was to fight the male ego. Women had to struggle at various levels in the society. Which has to be done even today. But the situation has changed a little now. Equal opportunities for women in all fields have not always been sought. The 73rd Amendment the Constitution of India was passed and women got 33 percent reservation in Local Self Government. Even today there is no participation of women in politics beyond reservation. Very few women are in politics. Speaking on this occasion, She also refered the female characters in Annabhau Sathe's literature. The struggle faced by women from mainstream groups has always been a big one. On this occasion he conveyed the message that every woman goes through a struggle but this struggle should be for equality.

Prof. Dr. Pushpa Gaikwad explained that we have embraced the process of urbanization, we have embraced technology, we have embraced higher education. But has there been a change in our thoughts?, how much have our thoughts progressed?, we should seriously think about this issue. If there are good things happening, we definitely think from the male point of view. The credit is usual given to men. But the credit is never given to women. At first we have to change ourselves. It is inevitable that we will struggle with what is wrong with us. And only if we make a change in ourselves through this struggle, we can guide the society to improve.





Maharaj Nagpur University, Nagpur, guided on 'Feminist Research and Oral History Writing'.
At this time, she explained that as a student of women's studies, it is important to use gender

perspective in our research. It is important for researchers to subtract ego and inferiority complex while conducting research. We have only an ideal heritage of oral history before our eyes, in which the oral stories of kings, palaces, gurus and great gurus are told to us. But the oral history of the oppressed Dalits, poor common people and women has not come to the fore. She further explained that oral history has the power to reconstruct history. As a student of women's studies, a woman-centered experience and gender perspective should be brought into our research and knowledge practice. Our commitment should not be limited to our studies alone. It is important to be sensitive and active in society. If we use a quotation in research, we should be able to analyze it. At the same time, while conducting research, linguistic identity should also be preserved while transliterating.

The creation of various branches of knowledge has been done to enrich human life, as well as to understand it, and to solve those questions. Our research topic should be relevant to the present time, we should be able to explain its importance, We should be able to determine the scope of the research, what exactly will be the benefit of the research? What will be the output of it? Also, what are the limitations of the research? It is also important to understand the exact concepts behind the research we are doing. Dr. Jayabhaye explained that we should be able to review the research in advance according to the objectives we are pursuing.



Speaking on this occasion Prof. Chandrakant Chavan said that the work of Ahilyabai Holkar was not only limited to religious matters but was an important and unique work done for the common people. She has not only thought about own institutions but built Panwathas (Water facilities) all over India for common people. Special water facilities were made for the animals. Many lakes were created. Many River ghats were built. Also, while ruling, discipline and rules are important and while following them, whether they are members of the family or in organizations, they kept the rules of discipline the same for all. Also, Ahilyabai had an equal attitude towards all the subjects. With the view that if the army is strong, the state will be safe, She created a drill force with the help of the French army. Also, in order to stop the robbery of many passengers on the Ghat route, she entrusted them with the task of collecting taxes without resorting to violence with the local people, and provided facilities that no one should be suffer in ghat Marg. She often tried to solve the problem peacefully and only if peace did not solve the problem, Ahilyabai took up arms. She always opposed the practice of dowry in the Sanstha, gave widows rights over their husbands' property, and gave them the right to adopt children of their own free will. Similarly, it was planned that the farmers would be taxed only one-fourth of their income. She built bridges over rivers, water facilities for animals, facilities of Hakeem, Vaidya for the treatment of snakebites or other physical causes, food umbrellas for the poor, distribution of blankets in winter, water bodies for water in summer, Dharamshalas. etc. She created many social useful services for the benefit of the common man throughout her tenure

and the most special thing is that she did not take any amount from the government during that time.

# 15. State Level Seminar on "Shyam Benegal: Pioneers of Parallel Female lead films" Date: 12-13 February 2025



Tarabai Shinde Women's Studies Centre, Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University, Chhatrapati Sambhajinagar organized a state level seminar on "Shyam Benegal: Pioneers of Parallel Female lead films" on 12<sup>th</sup> and 13<sup>th</sup> February 2025. This seminar was inaugurated by senior filmmaker and scholar Dr. Anil Salve. As the key note speaker on this occasion, Prof. Mustjeeb Khan, Head of English Department, Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University, seminar coordinator Dr. Ashwini More and Dr. Nirmala Jadhav, Director of Tarabai Shinde Women's Study Center were present.

Welcome speech was given by Dr. Nirmala Jadhav. She said that we see movies only as a means of entertainment. But films should also be seen in terms of understanding caste, class, gender, and other social issues. For the first time in the seventies, Shyam Benegal has tried to show women's issue caste and class dimensions through his films. Shyam Benegal's films like Ankur, Nishant, Manthan, Bhumika, Mandi, Mammo, Zubaida, Well Done Abba, need to be studied from a feminist point of view.

Speaking as inagurator, Dr. Anil Salve said that the lessons taught in school text book should be based on reality. The students should also lern about lessons from directors like Shyam Benegal, Satyajit Ray who displayed social issues through their films. The problems of women in the social system and the problems of caste are still serious. Many examples of caste inequality are seen even today. He asserted that films should look at the issues of the society and show the reality of the society through filmms.

The key note speaker Dr. Mustjeeb Khan said that, it is a tragedy that a film's popularity in India is determined on the basis of box office numbers. How many social issues have been shown in the film? we often ignore this. Also we have limited the review of the film only to the newspaper. Beyond that, we do not even think that it can be a matter of study. Indian film industry ranks second globally. But still we are behind in making some radical changes. For example, in the United States, it has been decided at a policy and government level that every film they produce must have African American characters. Moreover, they should not only be seen in cleaning or other simple tasks but should be working in a position of great authority. Therefore, itself becomes an important step towards social change through film. In the context of Indian films, however, we see representation of only a few groups in the social system. Not all common caste groups are seen and if it does, it appears only in certain works. Also, there can be space for creating social discord through this medium. And so, while watching the movie, we should watch it with a careful and prudent mind.



In the afternoon session, the films 'Nishant' and 'Well Done Abba', directed by Shyam Benegal, were screened.

Third Session Date: 13/02/2025

In the first session of the second day, Prof. Mustajib Khan delivered the lecture on 'Shyam Benegal and Parallel Films'. Dr. Nirmala Jadhav, Director of Tarabai Shinde Women's Studies Center, chaired the session, while Dr. Ashwini More, the seminar coordinator, present.

Prof. Dr. Mustajib Khan further explained that it is important for us to first understand why mainstream films, which we call mainstream films, have been categorized into mainstream films, parallel films, and popular films. And only then can we understand what parallel cinema is. Basically, during World War II, due to the conflict between Italy and Germany, all the theaters in Italy and Germany were destroyed. But then slowly, realistic films were made based on that medium. When it was realized that cinema was the best medium to influence people, parallel films began to be produced in the following years. For this, films were produced abroad using realistic and naturalistic mediums. In India, parallel films started coming out starting with Guru Dutt's 'Pyaasa'. Initially, they were called 'New realistic films'. Many of the films that came out later were melodramas, i.e. mainstream films, which do not reflect reality. These are just for entertainment. Things that make people happy are in mainstream films. Realization of the problems of life is only through parallel films. Social and political issues are only shown by parallel films. Shyam Benegal's films like *Manthan, Mandi, Ankur* try to show realistic situations. Parallel films try to present various issues in the society.

In the second session on the second day, the topic 'Female Image in Shyam Benegal's Films' was presented by Prof. Madhuri Dixit, Department of English, Premraj Sarada College, Ahilyanagar. Prof. Nisha Mude, Director, Department of Women's Studies, Shivaji University, Kolhapurchaired the sessin. On this occasion, Dr. Nirmala Jadhav, Director of Tarabai Shinde Women's Studies Center, as well as Dr. Ashwini More, Seminar Coordinator and Assistant Professor at Tarabai Shinde Women's Studies Center were present.

Prof. Dr. Madhuri Dixit said that, generally women are seen in films from the perspective of dance, music or money making and entertainment. In these mainstream films, no matter how modern women are, they are shown as secondary, traditional and domestic in front of men. An image of an ideal woman is created in which we see a woman bound by family, cultural, and social bonds from a social universal perspective. In contrast, the female characters in Shyam Benegal's films portray the importance of women on the periphery, their activism, awareness, their rights, their desires, strength, and images of women who work calmly and with purpose. This common woman seems far from the ideal female image in society. Speaking on this occasion, Prof. Madhuri Dixit gave a representative example of Benegal's film Manthan. Prof. Dr. Madhuri Dixit stated that Shyam Benegal's attempt to show Dalit women, upper caste women, their activism, as well as the upper caste society, as well as the urban and rural divide, is a way of connecting it to the realistic situation in society.



Tarabai Shinde Women's Studies Center, Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University, Chhatrapati Sambhajinagar, organized one day National Seminar on the occasion of International Women's Day, and tercentenary birth anniversary of Ahilyabai Holkar on "Rani Ahilyabai Holkar: Thoughts and Achievements", on 8<sup>th</sup> March 2025. Prof. Dr. Prashant Amritkar, Hon. Registrar of Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University was the chair persone of the seminar. The keynote speaker for this programme was Prof. Dr. Chandrakant Chavan from Walchand Arts and Commerce College, Solapur. On this occasion, Dr. Ashwini More, Co-Coordinator of the seminar and Dr. Nirmala Jadhav, Director of Tarabai Shinde Women's Studies Center were present.

While giving the welcome speech Dr. Nirmala Jadhav, Director of Tarabai Shinde Women's Studies Center, explained that Ahilyabai is an inspiration for this society. She faced many hardships and challenges in her family with great courage. She witnessed the death of his own relatives. But even then, she not only stood firm in life but also managed her kingdom with excellence. Also, we are celebrating International Women's Day today, but many women have struggled for this day to be celebrated. We should not forget that gegacy, said Dr. Nirmala Jadhav.

The chair person of the programme, Prof. Dr. Prashant Amritkar, said that the participation of men is important in the process of women's empowerment. He asserted that it is important to respect women as human beings and acknowledge their existence rather than recognizing them as goddesses.

Key note speaker Prof. Chandrakant Chavan explained that Ahilyabai Holkar's work was not limited to religious matters but was an important and unique work done for the common people. She did not only think about her own institutions, but she built water sources all over India. She made special water facilities for animals. She created many lakes. She built many ghats on river. Also, discipline and rules are important while ruling and while following them, She kept the rules of discipline the same for everyone, whether they were members of the household or in institutions. Ahilyabai also held a view of equality for all her subjects. With the view that if the army is strong, the state will be secure, she formed a drill force with the help of the French army. Also, to stop the robbery of many travelers on the Ghat route, she entrusted the task of collecting taxes without resorting to violence with the people there and ensured that no one would be robbed on the Ghat route in the future. She often tried to resolve issues peacefully and only if the issue could not be resolved peacefully did Ahilyabai take up arms. She always opposed the dowry system in her state, gave widows rights in their husband's property, She was given the right to adopt children of their own free will. Similarly, farmers were planned to be taxed at a rate of one-fourth of their income. She built bridges over rivers, water facilities for animals, medical facilities for snakebites or other physical ailments, as well as food shelters for the poor, distribution of blankets in the cold, during her entire tenure, she created many community-friendly service facilities such as water tanks, dharmashalas, etc. for water supply in summer. And the most special thing is that she did not take any amount of any kind from the government for this during that time.



18. Special online Guest Lecture on 'Globally Changing Nature of Employment and its Gender Perspectives'

Tarabai Shinde Women's Studies Centre, Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University, Chhatrapati Sambhajinagar organized a special guest lecture in online mode on 'Globally Changing Nature of Employment and its Gender Perspectives' of Professor Dr. Vibhuti Patel, former Professor, Tata Institute of Social Sciences, on 13<sup>th</sup> March 2025. Dr. Nirmala Jadhav, the coordinator of the programme and then Director of Tarabai Shinde Women's Studies Center, and co-coordinator of the programme, Dr. Ashwini More were present on the occasion.

In the introduction, Dr. Nirmala Jadhav, then director of the centre explained that, the Towards Equality report was published in India, the alarming level of women's participation in various fields came to light. Even today, if we look at it, women's work is not valued in the economy and they face wage discrimination. At the same time, we need to understand the implications of the upcoming AI technology, its effects, the effects of the recession from a development perspective and its overall gender implications.

Prof. Dr. Vibhuti Patel delivering her speech said that International Women's Day began to be celebrated after the March led by Clara Zetkin regarding women's employment and working hours. Thousands of women came together to demand their employment rights. Since then, as the pattern of economic development has changed, so have the new challenges and the nature of employment for women. Today, everyone is getting employment opportunities in large numbers. The mobility of workers in employment is increasing. But on the other hand, there is no guarantee or security of job. In the context of globalization and the overall socio-economic economy, it is understood that the labor force of the country is going out. In particular, 67 percent of the upper class youth have migrated abroad. They have cited social constraints and responsibilities as reasons for leaving the country. 25 percent of women are working in the agricultural sector. Currently, the largest number of women works in this service sector. A large number of women works in various places like beauty parlors, massage centers, gyms etc. However, the country's labor laws applyed in such places. This raises different questions. The contract labor is increasing. Thus we must have seen that during the Corona period and even now after, many women share their homemade products through social media and earn money from it. However, it is important to consider who is included and who is excluded in these social and economic networks. The International Labor Organization (ILO) has explained that about 94% of women work in the informal economy and therefore, we will have to understand women's issues in the changing nature of global employment.

The programme did anchoring Akash Lonkar. On this occasion the staff of Tarabai Shinde Women's Studies Center, Dr. Savita Bahirat, Mr. Santosh Lokhande, Mr. Sanjay Pol and students of the center participated in the lecture.






