- 6) Department plan to give more our extra curricular environment in the department with organizing more relate programs.



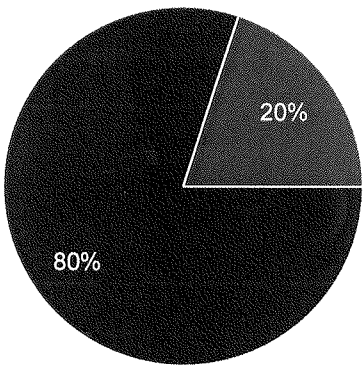

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


Report of the meeting


Date: 01/11/2021
