



1. We can see that the majority of responses fall into the "Outstanding" category, 34% out of 35 (100%) responses. This indicates that a significant portion of the feedback rated the clarity and identification of course and program objectives and outcomes as outstanding. 

the "Average" category. Overall, it appears that most respondents found the coarse material to be of good to excellent quality in terms of length, quality, and up-to-date content.
















9. The pie chart shows that the majority of respondents, 51%, rated the facilities as excellent.
