Action Taken on the basis feedback for the year 2018-19



The student feedback and its analysis was discussed thoroughly and its was resolved to initiate following action


- 1) The Department plan and suggest to our faculty to express course programmer objective & outcomes more cleared in further every class

Action Taken Report 2018-19 based on Students Feedback
